

## SUBMISSION FORM FOR AFB HONEY TESTING AND AFB/ EFB LARVAL SMEAR TESTING

Gribbles VETLAB is approved by Biosecurity SA to test (for South Australian registered apiarists):

- honey for American Foul Brood (AFB) - both for annual honey testing and as part of AFB management
- larval smears for American Foul Brood (AFB), European Foul Brood (EFB), and *Paenibacillus alvei* (a secondary infection of EFB infected larvae)

Each slide to only contain smears from one hive, be clearly labelled as per Submission Details, allowed to dry, and if not in slide holder, wrapped in Glad-wrap and then placed in break-proof container.

Samples must be sent to Gribbles VETLAB (address above) via post/freight OR via your nearest Australian Clinical Labs collection centre (visit [www.clinicallabs.com.au/location](http://www.clinicallabs.com.au/location))

Gribbles VETLAB can post collection materials to a nominated postal address:

- AFB honey sample kits (containing the requested number of 120 mL containers), at a delivery cost of \$20.00 for up to 8 x 120 mL containers
- AFB slide sample kits (containing the requested number of slides in slide holders, at a delivery cost of \$15.00 per package)

To enable annual honey test AFB test results to be submitted at registration, submit sample(s) at least 30 days prior to registration due date and only pay the Standard Fee. If sample(s) are submitted less than 30 days prior to registration due date you will need to pay the Priority Fee.
